

7 Day Namibian Deserts



Day 1: SUNDAY - Overnight WHK – WHK Country Club

Welcome to one of the most desolately placed capital cities in the world and your gateway to an exciting mix of dunes, deserts and ancient cultures. Arriving on flight one of our representatives will meet you and escort you to the hotel. You can enjoy a meal at the hotel but we do recommend a stop at the legendary Joe's Beerhouse for some awesome game meats in particular the Oryx Steak in a Dill and Garlic Butter Infusion – out of this world!

Your journey which will allow you views of the the Hyper Arid Namib National Park and infamous Sossusvlei then moves via the jagged and treacherous coastline to the original German Colonial town of Swakopmund. Spend a couple of days partaking in day tours to ancient rock art sites, get lost on a guided 4x4 expedition into the dunes in search of the elusive Welwitchia and the Aptly named moon Landscape. At night enjoy some genuine German Beer and tuck into original style Eisbein. Following a brief overnight in the City of Gold we fly you to Inhambane in Mozambique for a surreal appreciation of the majesty of the coastline and diving here.

Pulsing with life, opportunity and a sparkle of adventure, Windhoek is a multicultural city characterised by tranquil co-existence and enough lebensraum for all its citizens, which number 223 364(2001 census).You can enjoy the best of both worlds like the more European-style culture and comforts offered in the city, to the vivid drumbeats of Africa in its environs.

Day 2: Transfer to Namib – Sossusvlei Dune Lodge

Your private flight charter will depart WHK Eros airport at around 10am. Arriving at the Sossusvlei Dune Lodge Airstrip approximately 1 hour later - you will be met by a representative from the lodge and shown to your rooms and briefed on the area and issues of safety. After lunch you are invited to join a guide who will take you to view the Sesriem Canyon just down the road. Coming back to the lodge freshen up and cool down while the sun dips below copper dunes.

The Sossusvlei Dune Lodge is one of the newest additions to the Namibian Parks portfolio and offers an exclusive experience. With no other lodges and the only accommodation based in the park you will have access to the dunes and the silence of the desert as few are able to appreciate her.

Day 3: Sossusvlei Dune Lodge

Namib: a Khoikhoi (Hottentot) word meaning "desert" or "place of no people." Spend the day appreciating the wonder of this desert, the oldest oxidized red desert in the world, here the life cycle of a grain of sand and stand in awe as you realize the rich diversity of life in this inhospitable land.

The ocean winds and Benguela Current have a profound effect on the hyper-arid Namib ecosystem. They temper the climate of the coastal desert, bringing life to the shores, and allowing for sediments deposited into the ocean to be carried back inland to form the Namib's extensive dunes. In the early morning hours, the cooler waters of the Benguela interact with the warmer air to produce fog -- a life-giving fog that fosters the survival of the many creatures that exist on the inland dunes, we trust this is enough to whet your appetite for more on this – one of our favorite places on the planet.

Day 4: Swakopmund – Swakopmund Hotel

Your flight transfer from the airstrip will leave around 10 am and wind its scenic flight via Sossusvlei, "Old Diamond Mines", Conception Bay (Eduard Bohlen & Shaunee Shipwrecks), "Lange Wand", Sandwich Bay (Flamingo's), Walvis Bay (Salt pans) to Swakopmund drop off. The flight lasts approximately 2:15min and is the only way to fully appreciate the scale of the moving desert after having paced her skin yesterday.

On arrival you will be transferred to your hotel to check in and get the formalities out of the way. You are only a 5 min walk from the centre of town, however being a Sunday expect it to be quiet.

Swakopmund, known as Swakop in [Namibia](#) is the country's biggest coastal town and a mecca for Namibians on holiday. The city's German origins are quite pronounced in beautiful old German Colonial buildings throughout the city, making an even starker contrast for this town sitting at the edge of the Namib Desert. One artifact of the German colonization includes an old museum/store, selling genuine artifacts from the 19th century. Cover a child's eyes, because some of what is on sale is aesthetically--and historically--difficult to look at.

Day 5: Swakopmund – Swakopmund Hotel

You will make it back to the mainland for lunch and have the afternoon free.

Day 6: Swakopmund – Windhoek Country Club

Please ensure your bags are ready to be packed this morning as you will not be returning to the hotel.

You will head inland for approximately an hour to view the Matterhorn of Africa as well as some rock paintings left by the Khoi San a hybrid of the Khoi – Khoi and San peoples who roamed these plains. Other areas you will view are The Natural Bridge and the 3 areas of Spitzkoppe (the second highest peak in Namibia). After a lunch prepared for you at one of the sites you will make your way back to Swakopmund and partake in a 4 x 4 excursion to view the: Musical Rocks, Welwischia Plants, Swakop River Bed, Moon Landscape and the threatened Lichen Fields.

Your guide will then transfer you straight to the airport for your transfer to WHK at approximately 4pm.
