

FULL DAY HERMANUS TOUR



Departure: 08:15 – 08:30

Including: Sir Lowrys pass, Hermanus, Whale Spotting (in season), Clarens Drive, informal Wine Tasting.

Notes: Please note the best times of viewing are from July – November however there is always the possibility of spotting some of these gentle giants at other times of the year.

This circular tour takes you over The Sir Lowrys mountain pass to the seaside town of Hermanus. This town, nestled between mountains and the sea is not only very beautiful and historic but offers some of the best shore based whale watching opportunities in the world July to November.

Close sightings of the Southern Right whale are likely, and if fortunate 1 or 2 Humpbacks. On the return journey we follow the coastline via Clarens Drive and the breathtaking False Bay outline with the possibility of further sightings of whales (and even the possibility of sighting dolphins). A stop is made at Stoney Point, near Betty's Bay to have a look at the penguins (time permitting) and a wine tasting will be enjoyed before returning to Cape Town in the afternoon.
