FULL DAY TOURS

Nett Rate - US\$ 160 per person (including entrance fees)

A Taste of Nairobi:

Karen Blixen Museum - *"I had a farm in Africa, at the foot of the Ngong Hills'* for those lovers of "Out of Africa" the museum will take you back in time to breathe the spirit of the writer and the lives she immortalized.

The Giraffe Centre - This education centre gives you an opportunity to get up close and personal with Rothschild giraffes.

Lunch - Utumaduni - Utumaduni means "cultural heritage" and is a converted house containing (about 15) arts and crafts shops. There is also an outdoor restaurant called "The Verandah", ideal for lunch. **Extra cost.**

Matt Bronze - A selection of hand-made bronze gifts, from animal footprint ashtrays to bronze sculptures.

Kazuri Beads – Handmade, hand-painted ceramic jewellery. Every bead is shaped by hand by one of the 200 local women employed by Kazuri. Kazuri offers a fantastic tour to all visitors

Masai Collections - Contains a selection of numerous top designer clothes, shoes and other products.

The Historian:

The National Museums of Kenya - As a custodian of the country's national and cultural heritage, their principal mission is to *"collect, document, preserve and enhance knowledge, appreciation, management and use of these resources for the benefit of Kenya and the World."*

Nairobi National Archives - Opened in 1913, they store information dating back to the 19th century, on Kenyan history, wars, culture, politics, traditions etc. The public is welcome to visit and look through these documents.

Lunch - Lord Delamere Terrace, The Norfolk Hotel has played a leading role in Kenya's colorful history. The town and later the modern city of Nairobi grew up around it. **Extra Cost**

NAIROBI NATIONAL PARK

Daphne Sheldricks Orphanage – Get up close and personal with orphaned elephant (and often rhino). This is where Daphne Sheldrick has perfected the raising and re-integrating of orphaned elephants into the wild. **Open to the public from 11.00am until 12.00 daily.** Extra Park fees charged.
